




- generally accepted rules

- universal and general rules of life
- natural moral rules (lex moralis naturalis):
   inner motivation
- -to do the good
- -to avoid the bad
- examples
- –defense of life,

#### Written and unwritten rules

- •formal law vs. ethical/moral rules
- •"Unwritten rules do exist and those people, who sometimes make written rules a little bit softer, must strictly keep them." (Rejtő)

- case of Capitol Records v. Thomas-Rasset
- -1.500.000 USD for sharing 12 songs
- •Is it real and normal?
- Can the whole society be criminalized?
   (when anyone can up-/download music)

#### Copyright, movie

- •(Bodó, Lakatos, 2010):
- 3/4 of torrentable movies were not available in cinemas
- •How many cinemas in Bor? In Belgrade?
- •How many movies do exist?
- •Is it true that one download means one less cinema ticket?
- Can the whole society be criminalized?
   (when anyone can up-/download music)

# Copyright, books

- •What if the book cannot be bought in paper?
- •Should they be lost forever for the new generations?

# Copyright, software

- •Developer is not responsible for anything?
- •If you wanted to test a software before buying it?
- •If a student wanted to try out a particular sw?

# Copyright

- •Is downloading good for the society itself?
- •...for the bands and film studios?
- May free file-sharing make greater benefit...
- —...for the whole society than the losses of the industry?
- -...even for the industry itself?
