

## Erasmus+ STUDENT MOBILITY FOR TRAINEESHIP

**Erasmus+** fosters the mobility of students as well as academic and non-academic staff in higher education institutions. Eligible for participation in the Erasmus+ program are the **28 EU** member states as well as Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, the former Yugoslav republic Macedonia and Turkey.

Via Erasmus+, students can **study abroad for up to 12 months / study level** (Bachelor / Master / PhD).

## Advantages of an Erasmus+ stay

- Scientific exchange and new perspectives
- Building of intercultural european awareness
- Improved language skills
- Enhanced chances on the job market

## Application requirements

- Student status or recently graduated
- For recently graduated students, it is possible to apply for the Erasmus+ traineeship within 1 year after graduation
- Duration of traineeship: at least 2 full months max. 12 months
- Official working hours must be full-time
- Mandatory or voluntary traineeship possible
- Traineeship already possible from semester 1
- ➔ You can apply for the Erasmus+ scholarship for Internships at the international office of your home university.

## Scholarship amounts

- Erasmus+ mobility grant: €400- €500/month (depending on host country)
- Students with special requirements and students with kid(s) can apply for special grants funded by the EU
