Facts:


- University of Belgrade is the oldest state university in Serbia, founded in 1808

 - $\circ~$ 13 200 students with a Doctoral degree









- Approx. 500 books in the field of management theory and practice










Engineering Management study programs



Higher education entrance qualification






Engineering Management – Master academic studies








Conferences

- Number of participants and papers has been continually increasing






International Symposium on Environmental Management and Material Flow Management

 Organized since 2011, in cooperation with University of Trier (Germany) and University of Zenica (Bosnia and Herzegovina)


