### **Purpose:**

1.	<p>Professional practical work in an enterprise or institution will be carried out according to a predefined program plan – individual task, which consists of data collection, measurements and analysis, in consultation with experts from the enterprise where professional practice is carried out and professor-coordinator of the professional practice course.</p> <p>Upon completion of the professional practice visit, the student submits to the professor-coordinator a written journal with a description of the activities and work which the student performed during the professional practice.</p>
